

**ANDREWS TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
OF PUBLIC MEETING HELD MAY 29, 2018**

A public meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Andrews, Indiana convened on May 29, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Andrews Municipal Building in accordance with applicable law and pursuant to appropriate notice.

ROLL CALL:

Council Members William Johnson and Bonnie Walker were present. Clerk-Treasurer Laura Dillon declared a quorum was present and the meeting would continue. John Harshbarger was present midway into the meeting.

APPROVAL OF COUNCIL MINUTES

Bonnie Walker made a motion to approve the council minutes for the meeting of May 14, 2018, seconded by William Johnson. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Ordinance 2018-4, Ordinance for Additional Appropriation LRS Bridge Matching Grant (Community Crossing Matching Grant) of \$118,717.00 was discussed. This is the funding from the State of Indiana for the current CCMG paving project and the additional appropriation allows for the town to spend the funds by the Department of Local Government. Bonnie Walker made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2018-4 in the amount of \$118,717.00 on the second read, seconded by William Johnson. Motion passed unanimously. Ordinance adopted.

Dillon has completed a State Revolving Loan Request #25 for State Revolving Loan Funds for payment to Strand for \$27,245.38 for the new wastewater treatment plant. Bonnie Walker made a motion to approve the payment of \$27,245.38, seconded by William Johnson. Motion passed unanimously.

William brought up the fact of a violation of the Davis Bacon Act. R & R Steel was hiring undocumented workers at the wastewater treatment plant. A series of documents are being processed between attorney Mike Hartburg, Thieneman Construction and Region 3-A.

William Johnson announced Council member John Harshbarger has joined the meeting.

Ordinance 2018-5, An Ordinance of the Town of Andrews, Indiana Approving A Schedule of Rates and Charges for the Andrews Department of Stormwater Management Pursuant to Indiana Code 8-1.5-5. This ordinance if passed will include the Storm Water Management Ordinance into the town code. Bonnie Walker made a motion to approve Ordinance 2018-5 on the second read, seconded by John Harshbarger. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote. Ordinance adopted.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business to report.

Colin Bullock, utility superintendent was not present for this meeting.


Clerk-Treasurer Dillon reported on the process of mowing properties.


Bonnie Walker made a motion to approve the claims presented, seconded by John Harshbarger. Motion passed unanimously.
