AFFIDAVIT OF THOMAS WUENSCH

- 1. My name is Thomas Wuensch.
- 2. I am over the age of 18, am of sound mind, and have personal knowledge of the facts contained herein.
 - 3. I am the Andrews Dallas Township Volunteer Fire Chief.
 - 4. I have been an Andrews Dallas Township Volunteer Fireman since 1989.
 - 5. I have been the Andrews Dallas Township Volunteer Fire Chief since 2001.
- 6. On Monday, June 22, 2020, the Fire Department was paged to report to a semi-trailer fully involved.
 - 7. The fire was in a rural area.
 - 8. There were no fire hydrants available.
 - 9. Therefore, we had to use tanker trucks full of water to fight the fire.
- 10. After the fire was extinguished, we returned to the Fire Station and arrived at approximately 2:58 p.m.
 - 11. Attached to this affidavit is a true and accurate copy of the incident report.
- 12. Approximately ten to fifteen minutes later, we attempted to refill the tanker trucks using the Town of Andrews Municipal Water Supply.
- 13. We did not have normal water pressure when we attempted to refill the tanker trucks.
- 14. In fact, the pressure was so low that we could not even use the garden hose to rinse off our fire hoses.
- 15. I am extremely concerned about the lack of water pressure that currently exists on the Andrews Municipal Water Supply.

- 16. With the current situation, I do not believe I have enough water pressure to keep the tanker trucks adequately full of water to fight fires.
- 17. Additionally, with the lack of water pressure, I am concerned about what will happen if we cannot keep the tanker trucks full and have to use the Town's fire hydrants.
- 18. Because of the lack of water pressure, if we use the Town's fire hydrants, we might suck the water lines dry, which will leave voids and possibly damage the lines.
- 19. If that happens, the Town will be placed immediately under a Boil Water Advisory because of potential infiltration of bacteria.
 - 20. Further affiant sayeth naught.
- 21. I affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that the foregoing representations are true and correct.
